



***Under 16 Boys State Championships – COVID Safe Event Information
Thursday 7 – Sunday 10 April 2022
North Gold Coast***

Individuals MUST NOT attend basketball activities if they:

- Are feeling unwell and suffering from cold or flu-like symptoms
- Have tested positive for COVID-19 or is considered as a close contact of a COVID-19 case within the last 7 days
- Are a high health risk (due to age or pre-existing conditions)

Management of Unwell Participants & any Potential Outbreak

Any unwell participant will need to self-isolate and produce a negative COVID-19 result before returning to the venue.

In the event that there is a confirmed case of COVID-19 Basketball Queensland will follow all directions from Queensland Health. The course of action dictated by Queensland Health is impossible to determine, but it may require the stadium to be cleaned or, in an extreme case, the rest of the tournament may have to be cancelled.

Venue Entry Point

Coomera Indoor Sports Centre: Southern Entrance. Signage will be in use.

Venue Exit Point

Coomera Indoor Sports Centre: Southern Entrance.

Visitor Tracing/Ticketing System

No tickets sold at front door. Patrons must purchase tickets online.

A ticketing QR-code will be accessible at the venue to purchase tickets online, prior to entry.

All players, coaches, managers, and referees will not need to scan in. Team entry passes will not be issued this year.

Ticketing Requirements

There is no limit of spectators throughout the venue. Please maintain social distancing where possible.

Team Entry

Teams will be required to stay in plaza area, away from the venue entrance. 10 minutes prior to game starting, they can enter the venue. Teams will enter via southern entrance, then down the first tunnel to courts.

Spectator Entry

All spectators must provide ticket to enter the venue. Spectators can use stairs or lift to access the Level 1 viewing platform located directly above the main hallway, or spectators can use the second tunnel to access courts.

Post-Game

Teams to leave courts immediately after game.

All score tables and team benches/chairs to be wiped down and sanitized after each game. All scoring equipment including iPads to be cleaned and all basketballs to be sanitized before the next game.

Canteen

EFTPOS only.

PA System

Regular announcements will be made throughout each day reminding all patrons to practice social distancing.

Signage

Multiple signage will be placed around each venue reminding all patrons to practice social distancing, as well as personal hygiene requirements.

No results signs will be placed at the venue. All results and ladders will be on the BQ website and can be viewed using the QR code supplied. This is to alleviate any congestion of people around this area.

Tournament Office

Office located beside Court 3.

Team Passes

Team entry passes will not be issued for the State Championships. Each player, coach and manager must be dressed and ready to play before entering the stadium.

Water

Teams are permitted to bring their own water containers. These containers must be kept dry at all times to minimise water leakage on courts.

Changerooms

Changerooms to be closed at the venue, all players must come dressed and ready to play before each game.

Toilets

Toilets will be open and regularly cleaned by venue staff throughout the day.

Referee Meeting Areas

All referees to practice social distancing in their allocated meeting room.

Medal Presentations

Medal presentations for Boys Division 2, 3 and 4 will be completed in Hope Island Meeting Room B on Level 1, following medal games. Medal presentations for Boys Division 1 will take place on Court 2, following the gold medal game. Teams, officials, and spectators are to practice social distancing during this presentation.

Staff

The venue will have two biosecurity officers on hand as well as multiple court controllers. All directions from staff members must be adhered to.

State Championships Conditions of Entry

All participants and attendees at the 2022 State Championships are bound by the Basketball Queensland Conditions of Entry, BQ Codes of Behaviour, BQ Zero Tolerance Policy; and by any other Conditions of Entry & Policies as displayed by the venue.

If at any time a person is found to be breaching a code of conduct, the Zero Tolerance Policy or any condition of entry including this plan, they may be removed from the stadium by event staff and face further penalty under the Basketball Queensland Tournament Tribunal Policy, which will be enforced by the Tournament Technical Committee comprising of the Basketball Queensland Representative, Referee's Commissioner and Host Association Representative.

This document is subject to change at any time if restrictions are either lifted or enhanced before the commencement of the tournament.
