

2020 Molten CBSQ Junior Secondary - COVID Safe Event Information Thursday 15 - Sunday 18 October 2020

Logan Metro Sports Centre Cornubia Park Sports Centre Auchenflower Stadium

Individuals MUST NOT attend basketball activities if they:

- Are feeling unwell and suffering from cold or flu-like symptoms
- Have tested positive for COVID-19 or have come in contact with a known or suspected COVID-19 case within the last 14 days
- Are a high health risk (due to age or pre-existing conditions)
- Have travelled to a COVID declared hotspot

Management of Unwell Participants & any Potential Outbreak

Any unwell participant will need to self-isolate and produce a negative COVID-19 result before returning to the venue.

In the event that there is a confirmed case of COVID-19 Basketball Queensland will follow all directions from Queensland Health. The course of action dictated by Queensland Health is impossible to determine, but it may require the stadium to be cleaned or, in an extreme case, the rest of the tournament may have to be cancelled.

Venue Entry Point

Logan Metro Indoor Sports Centre - Front Main Entry of Stadium Cornubia Park Sports Centre - Front Main Entry of Stadium Auchenflower Stadium - Front Main Entry of Stadium

Venue Exit Point

Logan Metro Indoor Sports Centre - Front Main Entry of Stadium, divided down the corridor. Cornubia Park Sports Centre - Fire exits for Court 1 & 2. Rock wall fire exit for Courts 3 & 4. Auchenflower Stadium - Each court has it's own exit. No exit through the main entry.

All teams must leave the venue immediately after their game has been played. Team meetings must be held outside.

Visitor Tracing

Any spectators who wish to enter the venue must sign in using the QR code provided at the front door. There may also be a manual sign-in sheet at each venue.

All players, coaches, managers, and referees will not need to scan in.

Team Entry

The two referees for the game will collect the teams from outside the stadium. Teams will enter via designated Court Allocation entry point at each venue, only once the previous game has finished and the bench has been sanitized.

Spectator Entry

The two referees for the game will collect the spectators for each game from outside the stadium. Once courts have been cleared, spectators may enter the seating galleries.

Spectator Restrictions

The below table lists the maximum number of spectators allowed per court at each venue. All spectators are required to physically distance by 1.5m apart. Spectators must vacate the venue once each game has finished.

The grandstand will be used for the medal games on Day 4. The grandstand will seat 270 spectators.

Post-Game

Teams must leave the venue immediately after the game has finished. There is to be no handshaking between teams or referees before or after the game.

All score tables and team benches/chairs will be wiped down and sanitized after each game. All scoring equipment including iPads will be cleaned and all basketballs to be sanitized before the next game.

Canteen

The canteen at each venue will be open with EFTPOS only.

Sanitisation

Required on entry and available around the stadium and each scoretable. Team basketballs to be wiped at each bench.

Water

Players must bring their own water bottles. Water cannot be filled up within the stadium. Teams are not permitted to bring their own communal water containers. It is recommended that teams prepare for this in advance by purchasing bottled water throughout the day.

PA System

Regular announcements will be made throughout each day at each venue reminding all patrons to practice social distancing.

Signage

Multiple signage will be placed around each venue reminding all patrons to practice social distancing, as well as personal hygiene requirements.

Signs will also indicate each entry and exit point as well as spectator areas and maximum number of patrons allowed in each area.

No results signs will be placed at the venue. All results and ladders will be on the BQ website and can be viewed using the QR code supplied. This is to alleviate any congestion of people around this area.

Changerooms

Changerooms to be closed at all venues, all players must come dressed and ready to play before each game.

Toilets

Toilets will be open and regularly cleaned by venue staff throughout the day.

Photography and Video Taping

Spectators who are wishing to take photos or videos at the event must use the Photo/Video Register QR code at the Tournament Office upon entering the stadium.

Photo/video is only permitted to be taken from designated spectator seating areas.

Personnel on scorebench, and players/officials on the team bench, <u>are not</u> permitted to take photos or video during games.

Live Streaming

Court 2 at Logan Metro will be live streamed by the Courier Mail for the duration of the event.

Medal Presentations

Medals will be given to teams after each game in which a medal is decided. Teams are to practice social distancing while waiting to receive and collect their medals. No team photos are allowed after receiving medals. All teams must vacate the court immediately after their medals are presented.

Venue Staff

The venue will have biosecurity officers on hand as well as multiple court controllers. All directions from staff members must be adhered to.

CBSQ Conditions of Entry

All participants and attendees at the 2020 CBSQ are bound by the Basketball Queensland Conditions of Entry, BQ Codes of Behaviour, BQ Zero Tolerance Policy; and by any other Conditions of Entry & Policies as displayed by the venue.

If at any time a person is found to be breaching a code of conduct, the Zero Tolerance Policy or any condition of entry including this plan, they may be removed from the stadium by event staff and face further penalty under the Basketball Queensland Tournament Tribunal Policy, which will be enforced by the Tournament Technical Committee comprising of the Basketball Queensland Representative, Referee's Commissioner and Qld School Sport Representative.

This document is subject to change at any time if restrictions are either lifted or enhanced before the commencement of the tournament.
